


Fig 2. Number of reported sea turtle species.




Fig 3. Overview of the amount of different of interactions.




Fig 5. Reported interactions by state or territory.




Fig 6. Reported interactions by month.




Fig 7. Reported sea turtle classes.




Fig 8. Each percentage represents the proportion of the type of bait used during the time of the reported interaction.





Fig 9. Each percentage represents the proportion of the type of hooks used during the time of the reported interaction.
