During the month of August, local volunteers conducted beach cleanups in Juno beach. Following each beach and underwater cleanup, LMC's conservation department sorts and analyzes 25% the debris collected. The debris removed during the cleanup was sorted and data collected in alignment with best practices as outlined by our partners at NOAA and the Ocean Conservancy.

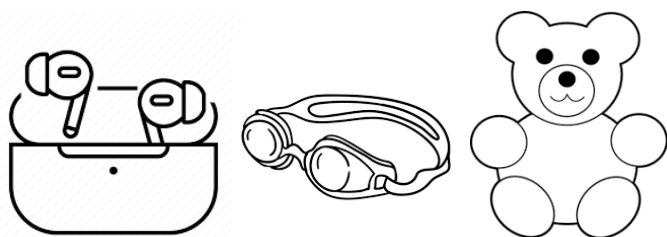


Figure 1. Air pods, goggles, and a teddy bear were found at beach cleanups in August

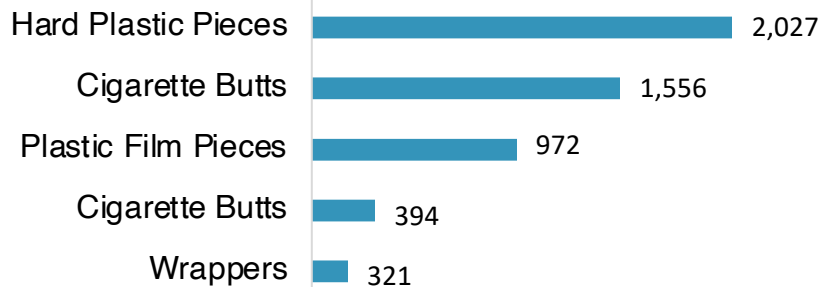


Figure 2. Top 5 items collected in August 2023.

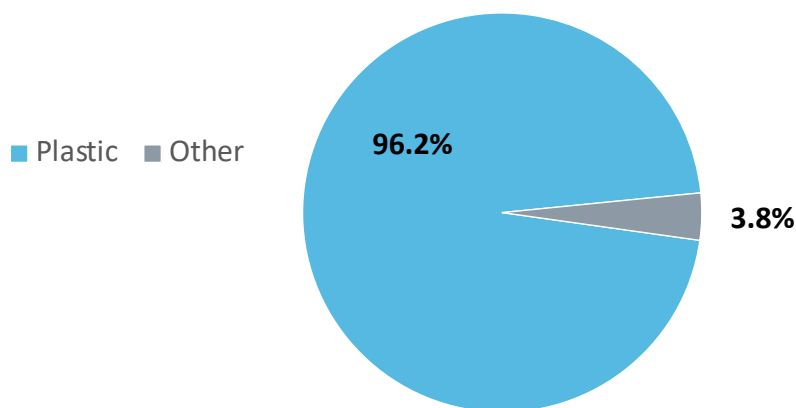


Figure 3. 96.2% of all debris removed was plastic.
