July 2025



During the month of July, local volunteers conducted beach cleanups in Juno beach. Following each beach and underwater cleanup, LMC's conservation department sorts and analyzes 25% the debris collected. The debris removed during the cleanup was sorted and data collected in alignment with best practices as outlined by our partners at NOAA and the Ocean Conservancy.

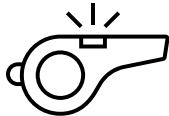
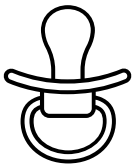


Figure 1. Unusual items found during the month of July included 2 pacifiers, a whistle, and a fake plant!

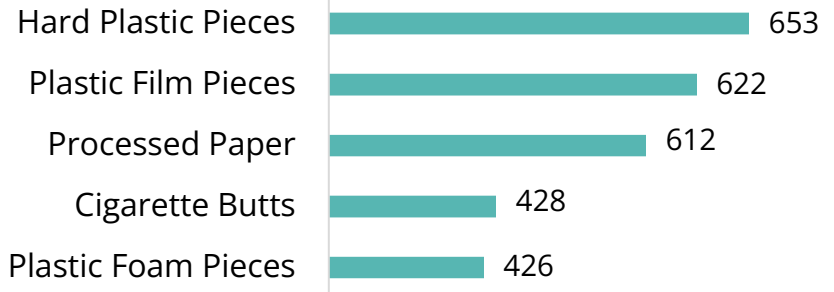




Figure 2. Top 5 items collected during July 2025.

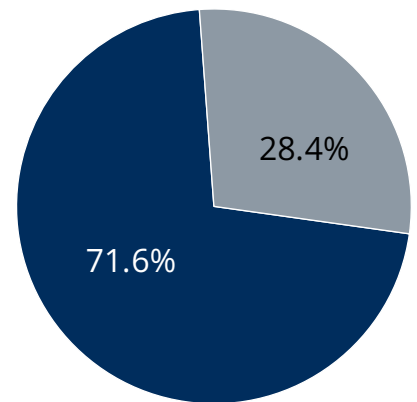


Figure 3. 71.6% of all debris removed was plastic.
