November 2025



During the month of November, local volunteers conducted beach cleanups in Juno beach. Following each beach and underwater cleanup, LMC's conservation department sorts and analyzes 25% the debris collected. The debris removed during the cleanup was sorted and data collected in alignment with best practices as outlined by our partners at NOAA and the Ocean Conservancy.

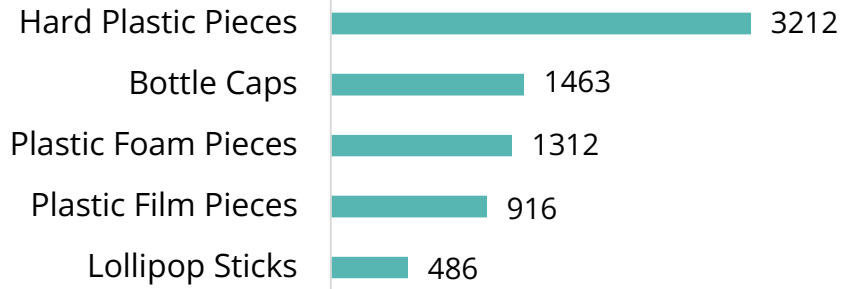





Figure 2. Top 5 items collected during November 2025.

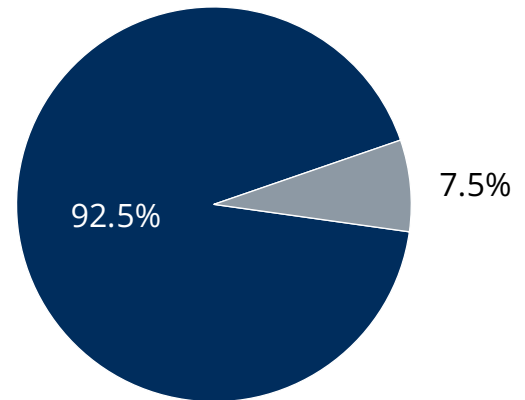


Figure 3. 92.5% of all debris removed was plastic.
