**June 2023** 



Following each beach and underwater cleanup, LMC's conservation department sorts and analyzes 25% of the debris collected. In the month of June, volunteers conducted beach cleanups in Juno Beach, FL. The debris removed during the cleanup was sorted and data collected in alignment with best practices as outlined by our partners at NOAA and the Ocean Conservancy.




Figure 1. Some unusual items found during the month of June included a fake octopus arm and a skateboard wheel.




Figure 2.Top 5 items collected in June, 2023.

Refuse disposable plastic utensils when ordering takeout or delivery. Try utensil sets made from sustainable materials, like bamboo, as an alternative.




Figure 3. 85.1% of all debris removed was plastic.
